The United States Postal Inspection Service has received complaints concerning theft of mail from a US Postal Service Mailbox in your area. We need your assistance in identifying any fraudulent activity associated with the theft.

Mail thieves target mailboxes to gain access to your personal and financial information. Using this information, identity thieves can open financial accounts including bank and credit card accounts in your name. Checks stolen from the mail can be forged, altered or counterfeited and subsequently negotiated at banks and retail businesses. Please continue to monitor all your accounts for any type of fraudulent activity.
