

Dr. Horton's 62 home subdivision is currently putting in sewer lines is less than 1/10th of a mile from the Proposed plant

Mt. View Estates & Curtin creek condos approximately 140 homes are within 1/6 of a mile from plant

Cedar49 approximately 235 homes are within 1/5 of a mile - in total around 500 homes are within 1/3 mile of the proposed plant to the east

and another 200 within 1/3 mile to the west. Also, to note Curtin Creek Wetlands is within 1/3 of a mile

Noise pollution is one of the major concerns we have, let's talk about cause & effect

let's start with Cause-

This is a like cement plant operated by CalPortland located in the industrial area in the port of Vancouver.

I adjusted to 66 decibels which is the same noise level to be heard in the closest neighborhood locate less than

1/10th mile from plant

Play Back the Beep beep beep video 2X -

I played this 2 times, now play this over another 198 more times in your own head which is the number of trucks possible per day

Knife river said was possible to back up to their silo to load concrete on our zoom meeting two weeks ago.

This was Played at 68 decibels the level to be heard in new subdivision

Not to mention a portable rock crusher that will be used to recycle concrete which runs at 90-120 decibels

Effects associated with noise pollution like you just heard-

studies have shown noise pollution not only drives hearing loss, but also is linked to high blood pressure, heart disease,

cardiovascular disease, type 2 diabetes; sleep loss, stress. mental health issues, including memory impairment

and attention deficits associated with childhood learning disparities.

Can you imagine you or your kids exposed to these sounds 24 hours a day - 7 days a week?
