Known hazards from a concrete batch plant and cement recycler include:

- Particulate matter including concrete and silica dust damaging our lungs, roofs, and gardens
- Noise pollution from the plant and vehicles, along with ground vibration
- Light pollution - Knife river wants to run this plant 24 hours a day
- Run off into the wetlands, killing wildlife and seeping into the surrounding water table
- Reduced property values, which many of us count on for retirement security
